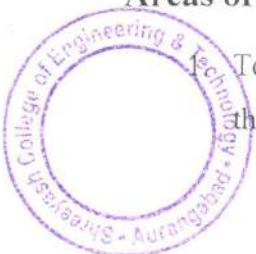

Recitals

- BE-TECH Toolings & Automation (I) Pvt. Ltd., Aurangabad (M.S.) is in the business of manufacturing SPM, dies, fixtures, gauges, etc.
- The purpose of this M.O.U. is with reference to exploring the areas of cooperation, benefiting both **the institute and the industry** (hereinafter collectively referred to as “the parties”).

Areas of cooperation

To impart training to the students and faculty members of the institute by the industry and to the employees of the industry by the institute.



2. To facilitate regular interaction between the faculty members & students of the institute and the workforce of the industry.
3. The parties shall explore the possibilities of mutual support in their learning, hiring and research requirement based on mutual convenience.

7. Neither this M.O.U., nor any activities described herein, shall be construed as creating a partnership, joint venture or other such relationship. Both parties agree that this M.O.U. represents a nonexclusive relationship between the parties and nothing contained herein shall preclude either party from participating/initiating similar relationship with third parties.
8. This M.O.U. may not be amended without the prior written consent of both the parties.
9. **Termination:** Either party can cancel or terminate this Agreement unilaterally (and without reason), by giving an advance written notice of one month to the other.
10. **Indemnity:** Each of the parties shall defend, indemnify and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, liability, loss, costs or expenses (including reasonable Attorney's fees) arising out of or resulting from the material breach of the provisions herein.

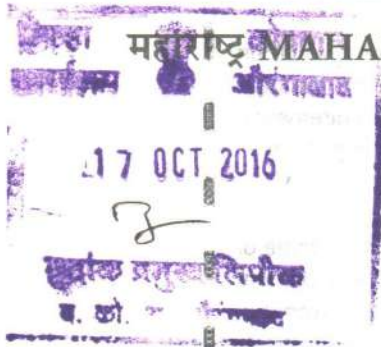

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Objectives of the Collaboration:

This Memorandum of Understanding is to conduct a Unique, Step – By – Step, Systematic, and Employable Skills Development Program for the students towards achieving the objective of maximizing the employable opportunities.

This Memorandum of Understanding states the terms and conditions under which the Trainings shall be conducted **ABC TNC** through its Aurangabad Centre at the premises of **Shreeyash College Of Engineering & Technology**, and lists herein the respective responsibilities of both parties.

PREAMBLE:

College Shall Provide:

- The required number of computer systems in the lab and other required infrastructure for the practice

- The Class rooms with LCD projector for the theory classes.
- The Schedule with the classes for this training during the upcoming months.
- The supports to ensure, all students who have signed up for the class, attend the training programs scheduled for them.
- The relevant software installed in the computer systems.
- Disciplinary support for the smooth conduct and timely completion of the entire course.
- Provide all support to our Company in the marketing initiatives undertaken to enroll students in the courses offered.College will provide all infrastructural facilities for the marketing initiatives undertaken by our company..

PARTICIPANTS:

The participants would be the Students of College from All branches to the Semesters mentioned in ANNEXURE 1.

COURSE CONTENTS:

ABC T&C and its Business Partner in consultation with College shall finalize the courses and fees for the skills development program. The same is provided in the Annexure – 1. These will be reviewed every year and suitable changes, if required, will be incorporated. As the requirement of each course is different, courses and fees have been worked out separately for each branch.

TIME SCHEDULE

The program(s) will be conducted during the days and timings provided by College. The students will be divided into batches, depending on the total strength. The program(s) will be conducted according to the Time Table drawn up with the mutual consent of Company and College. Utmost care will be taken to frame the time table in such a way that it does not coincide with college exams enabling the student to complete his training ahead of the exams. Company will not conduct any classes during the time of exams. In case of any change in training schedule the same will be intimated to the Programme Coordinator of College. Similarly, if College wants a change in training schedule the same may be communicated to the Programme Coordinator of Company. In either of the cases, a revised training schedule has to be made and the Programme Coordinators of both Company & College and the respective students must be informed about the change in training schedule by means of suitable media (emails/posters/circulars/notice board displays).

Programme Coordinator

The Director of College shall appoint a "Programme Coordinator" from each department for the duration of the program, who shall liaise with our Company and make the training process learner-friendly and effective. Our Company shall work in close relationship with the Programme Coordinator, who in-turn shall keep a close touch with the students. In the event of any difference of opinion between Company and the Programme Coordinator, the matter should be referred to the Director of College, whose decision thereon shall be final and binding on both the parties.

COMMENCEMENT OF COURSE

College will ensure that the courses will start within 90 (Ninety) days from the date of signing of MOU. Our Company will ensure that the courses will commence from **(DATE, Month & Year)** on intimation from College. However exception can be made due to reasons mentioned in the Course Completion Clause or due to delay on Name of College's side.

COURSE FEES & PAYMENT PATTERN

The course fee per student for each course offered is decided and mutually agreed upon by both the parties. The course fee and the payment pattern are available in the Annexure – 1. The student shall pay the course fee directly to College/centre before the start of the course.

College will make payment by Cheque or DD payable at Aurangabad in the name of **ABC Trainers and Consultants**.

Company shall refund the course fee if courses are not provided as stated in Annexure 1. The Fees for College are mentioned in Annexure 1. In the event of any student not able to attend and is missing out the entire session of classes, College shall not make the payment towards that student. The amount such paid is subject to tax deduction at source. College will provide tax deduction at source certificate for the same. College will take the responsibility of collecting fees from the students.

COURSE COMPLETION:

While ABC T&C through its Business Partner will endeavor to complete the course as per the schedule mutually agreed upon and mentioned in Annexure 1. ABC T&C will not be responsible and accountable for delay in completing the course due to reasons which are beyond the control of ABC T&C and ABC T&C's Business Partner. Reasons beyond the control of ABC T&C and ABC T&C's Business Partner include – acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities (regardless of whether war is declared), civil war, rebellion, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power or confiscation, terrorist activities, nationalization, government sanction, blockage, embargo, labor dispute, strike, lockout or interruption or failure of electricity or telephone service, failure and non – availability of Computer Systems, non – availability of Classrooms), law and order problems, students unrest/strike/boycott, unscheduled changes in college curriculum and other unforeseen circumstances.

- Courses for individual software will be completed as mentioned in ANNEXURE 1.
- Terms & Conditions as mentioned in ANNEXURE 2.

While it is mandatory for the student to have undergone the complete course as mentioned in ANNEXURE 1 to be eligible for a Course Completion Certificate. In case he/she opts out due to any reason an appropriate certificate will be issued for only for that course completed by the student. Students will not be eligible for Certification for the courses that they have not completed.

Neither ABC T&C nor ABC T&C's Business Partner will issue "Certificate of Completion" to the successful student, if full payment is **not** made. Neither ABC T&C nor ABC T&C's Business Partner will refund the fees once paid if the student opts out or discontinues the course at any stage due to any reason.

EXCLUSIVITY

Name of College will ensure that during the period of the MOU, Name of College will not allow or permit any of the direct and indirect competitors of ABC T&C to either do any promotional activities, advertising in any form, publicity of any kind, canvass for students and enroll the students. The courses will be conducted by ABC T&C and its Business Partners only.

JURISDICTION

All matters, queries, disputes or differences, whatsoever, arising between the parties touching the construction, meaning, operation or effect of this Memorandum of Understanding or out of or relating to this Memorandum of Understanding or breach thereof shall be settled through arbitration in accordance with the relevant Arbitration Act in force at such time. The Arbitration award shall be binding on both parties.

1. College will not entertain any other Institutions for the same Service.
2. Payment of Courses will be taken in advance.
3. Certification will be provided in Digital format

VALIDITY

Both Name of College and ABC T&C shall have the rights to terminate this MOU by providing **THREE** months notice in writing on their respective letter head only after a minimum period of one year. Termination of this MoU for whatever reason shall be without prejudice to the rights of either party and of the students and the ongoing academic programmes.





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

The individuals signing this MOU on behalf of their respective entities represent and warrant (without personal liability therefor) that upon the signature of each, this MOU shall have been duly executed by the entity each represents.

VII. TRANSFER OF FUNDS.

The parties acknowledge and agree that this MOU does not create any financial or funding obligation on either organization, and that such obligations shall arise only upon joint execution of a subsequent MOU or work plan (which shall include a budget) that specifically delineates the terms and nature of such obligations and that references this MOU. University and having its campus at Gut no.258, Satara Parisar, Near SRPF Camp, Beed by-Pass Road, Aurangabad, Maharashtra - 431010


And

Tata Technologies Limited, (hereinafter referred to as “**Tata Technologies**”) is a company registered under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 having its registered office at 25, Rajiv Gandhi Infotech Park, Hinjawadi, Pune – 411 057.

In course of this MOU, both the parties to the MOU mentioned above have been individually referred to as “Party” and jointly as “Parties”.

WHEREAS Tata Technologies under the aegis of the Corporate Sustainability Program (CSP), has identified the need for imparting quality training in the “Product Development” domain to Engineering Students across the engineering colleges in the country. The main intent behind this initiative is to better equip young engineers and to increase their awareness and industry connect. **Ready Engineer (RE)** is a voluntary initiative running under the umbrella Program called “**Ready Engineer**”, Tata Technologies has conceptualized and designed a course for the entire training.

AND WHEREAS, **Shreeyash College of Engineering & Technology** strives to serve as a Centre for fostering co-operation and exchange of ideas between the academic and research community on one hand and the industrial and Governmental employers on the other, and to promote entrepreneurship among the students & to co-operate with industries both in public and



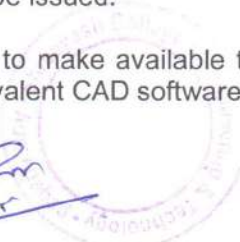
private sectors with a view to devising courses of instruction which would meet the requirements of such industries.

AND WHEREAS, both the parties have expressed a common interest in providing industry relevant training to the engineers, enhance their awareness, expand their industry connect and in the process, increase their employability.

The Parties intend to enter in to this MOU to provide a frame work as per below terms and conditions to evaluate the area of collaboration between them and establish certain rights and obligations between the Parties during such evaluation.

Terms and Conditions

1. Tata Technologies' experts and experienced Design Engineering specialists have created an e-learning module hosted on iGET IT or an equivalent platform (as decided by Tata Technologies at that point of time) which will be licensed for use to selected engineering students of **SCET**.
2. Apart from Design Engineering module, Tata Technologies has also included trainings on Soft Skills and Scholarships for NPTEL Course Assessments as a part of Ready Engineer Program.
3. The RE program in partnership with **SCET** will be implemented based on a HUB and SPOKE model or any other methods as agreed mutually. Any revision to the implementation model for the program will be decided by Tata Technologies in due course of time in consultation with college. Refer the current responsibilities of HUB college in Annexure A.
4. The terms and conditions of the license to use the program will be provided by Tata Technologies. Software and documentation, databases, reports and other copyrightable materials, product designs, inventions, discoveries, developments and improvements written, invented, made or conceived during or arising out of the joint activity performed under this MOU and thereafter shall be jointly owned by **SCET** and Tata Technologies.
5. Tata Technologies will bear all the expenses in implementation of this program through its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funding or otherwise.
6. There is a nominal subscription fee of INR 300 charged per student per year from HUB and Satellite Colleges. The College would coordinate the collection of this amount from each satellite college and the disbursement be made by HUB/Satellite college in consultation with Tata Technologies. The said amount collected, will strictly be used to facilitate the RE Program and/or conduct CSR activities in the respective colleges and an account summary of the balance amount should be submitted to Tata Technologies at the end of every academic year.
7. RE training may require tests to be conducted on a regular interval during the entire course of program to evaluate the students' performance and upon completion, appropriate certificate will be issued.
8. **SCET** commit to make available the students, professors, training rooms and licensed CATIA or equivalent CAD software on work stations during the training of the RE program





as may be required. This is necessary for a successful implementation and completion of the RE program. However, if the college has any other licensed CAD software like CREO, UGNX, SOLIDWORKS, SOLID EDGE, they can use it instead of CATIA.

9. Tata Technologies may give the opportunity to the qualified Ready Engineer students (who also fulfil the selection criteria set out by HR, Tata Technologies) to attend campus interviews however subjected to the recruitments plan/policy of the company.
10. Proprietary information disclosed by Tata Technologies in the course of discussions and training under this MOU shall be kept highly confidential. College shall not use Tata Technologies' name or its trademarks or make any reference to the MOU or the RE program in any manner of publicity without Tata Technologies' prior written consent.
11. **SCET** is aware that the business activities of Tata Technologies are self-regulated by the "Tata Code of Conduct" which is incorporated by reference herein. It can be accessed and downloaded from <http://www.tatatechnologies.com>.
12. This MOU is effective from the date of signing and will remain valid unless terminated by either Party, upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other Parties.
13. It is also agreed upon that the MOU does not restrict Tata Technologies Ltd to implement RE program in other university/institutes.
14. Neither this MOU nor any negotiations or other understandings prior or pursuant to the execution of the MOU shall constitute a binding and legally enforceable agreement, nor give rise to any liability, between the Parties. Notwithstanding the foregoing, however, the provisions of "Confidentiality", "Intellectual Property Rights" and "Term and Termination" shall be binding upon and enforceable in accordance with their terms against the parties and their successors and permitted assigns.

Responsibilities of Hub College (HC)

a) MOU

- HC shall host the MOU signing meeting and make necessary arrangement.
- HC shall coordinate with satellite colleges for MOU signing meeting.

b) Professor Training (Train the Trainer)

- HC will host training program and make necessary arrangement.
- HC will nominate SPOC (Single Point of Contact) professor responsible for the entire coordination of Ready Engineer course with satellite colleges.
- HC SPOC will be the link between Tata Technologies & satellite colleges for all communication related to Ready Engineer course.
- HC will nominate 3 to 4 professors for the training program and ensure all attain it.
- HC will maintain all the data related to training.

c) Enrollment

- Interested students from second & third year Mechanical Engineering branch only are eligible to enroll for this program.
- For Second Year Students, the course shall contain Personality Assessment Test, Soft Skill Training Level - 1 and NPTEL scholarship for course assessment.
- For Third Year Students, the course shall contain Employability Assessment Test, Soft Skill Training Level - 2, Technical Domain training and NPTEL scholarship for course assessment.
- Tata Technologies after mutual discussing will all colleges will set a deadline for the enrollment, HC will ensure about receiving the enrollment data from all satellite colleges as per the deadline.
- HC will maintain master sheet of the enrolled students which will consist students name, email id, mobile numbers and college id number from satellite colleges.
- This master sheet will be shared with Tata Technologies for getting iGETIT license.
- Tata Technologies will generate the licenses of iGETIT and share the same to respective college after receiving the enrollment data.
- For any query regarding iGETIT license, college will coordinate with Tata Technologies.

d) Course Conduct

- Hub College would be the primary facilitator of Ready Engineer Program and would ensure the smooth functioning of the program in all the satellite colleges.
- Should provide a platform for piloting and providing feedback of any new course content added in later stage to take the RE initiative to the next level.
- HUB College should proactively inform or suggest any changes that may be required in the long term, (syllabus change in University or additional allied branches that the satellite college have expanded) to scale up the RE initiative.
- In case any college fails to conduct a batch in a particular year, they will have to justify the reason for not conducting the course, which will be reviewed by Tata Technologies and the decision for course continuation will be taken accordingly.
- Training module be equally divided with the trained professor in order to avoid any load on a particular professor.



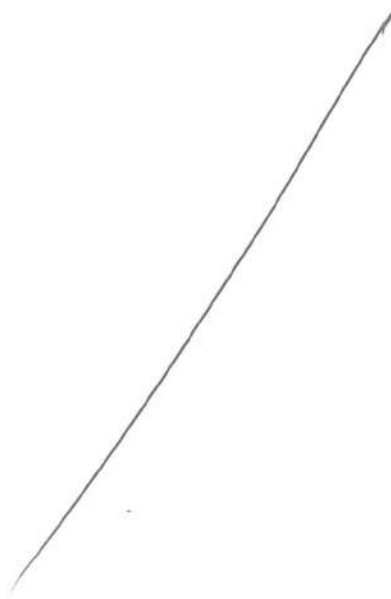
- In case any of the trained DRE professor or SPOC resigns / transfers, same should be updated to Tata Technologies and handover the details to concerned person.
- HC after mutual discussion with all satellite colleges will decide start & end date for Ready Engineer program and share with Tata Technologies.
- All college will prepare a training calendar for Ready Engineer program. HC will share this training calendar with Tata Technologies before commencement of program.
- HC will share the course progress of all satellite college with Tata Technologies on monthly basis.
- Every college will conduct one volunteering activity per batch under Ready Engineer volunteering campaign. HC will share this data with Tata Technologies.

e) Examination

- Hub College will assist in finalizing the exam centers
- HC after mutual discussion with satellite college will decide the exam date and convey the same to Tata Technologies.
- HC will ensure the smooth operation of examinations as per the schedule.
- HC will ensure maximum attendance of registered students from satellite colleges for Ready Engineer exam.
- HC will collect the prerequisite data like number of computers, OS etc. from satellite colleges required for conducting the exam and share with Tata Technologies.
- In case of any variation in registered students and those appearing for final Ready Engineer exam, HC shall escalate to Tata Technologies.

f) Certification

- Students qualifying the final DRE exam will be awarded the Certified Ready Engineer certificate.
- Tata Technologies will distribute the certificates to each college separately.
- HC will confirm about all satellite college receiving the certificates.



Annexure B
Responsibilities of Satellite College (SC)

a) MOU

- SC will coordinate with the HUB college for MOU signing meeting.

b) Professor Training (Train the Trainer)

- SC will nominate SPOC (Single Point of Contact) professor responsible for the entire coordination of Ready Engineer course.
- SC will share the details of the nominated professor for training to Hub College.
- SC will nominate 3-4 professors for the training program and ensure all attain it.
- SC will maintain all the data related to training.

c) Enrollment

- Interested students from second & third year Mechanical Engineering branch only are eligible to enroll for this program.
- For Second Year Students, the course shall contain Personality Assessment Test, Soft Skill Training Level - 1 and NPTEL scholarship for course assessment.
- For Third Year Students, the course shall contain Employability Assessment Test, Soft Skill Training Level - 2, Technical Domain training and NPTEL scholarship for course assessment.
- Tata Technologies after mutual discussing will all colleges will set a deadline for the enrollment, SC will make sure the enrollment data from their colleges is submitted to the HUB college before the deadline.
- SC will maintain master sheet of the enrolled students which will consist students name, email id, mobile numbers, college id number.
- Tata Technologies will generate the licenses of iGETIT and share the same to respective college after receiving the enrollment data.
- For any query regarding iGETIT license, college will coordinate with Tata Technologies.

d) Course Conduct

- SC should provide a platform for piloting and providing feedback of any new course content added in later stage to take the Ready Engineer initiative to the next level.
- SC should proactively inform or suggest any changes that may be required in the long term, (syllabus change in University or additional allied branches expansion) to scale up the DRE initiative.

- SC will follow the start & end date for Ready Engineer program (mutually decided by all colleges) and share with HUB college.
