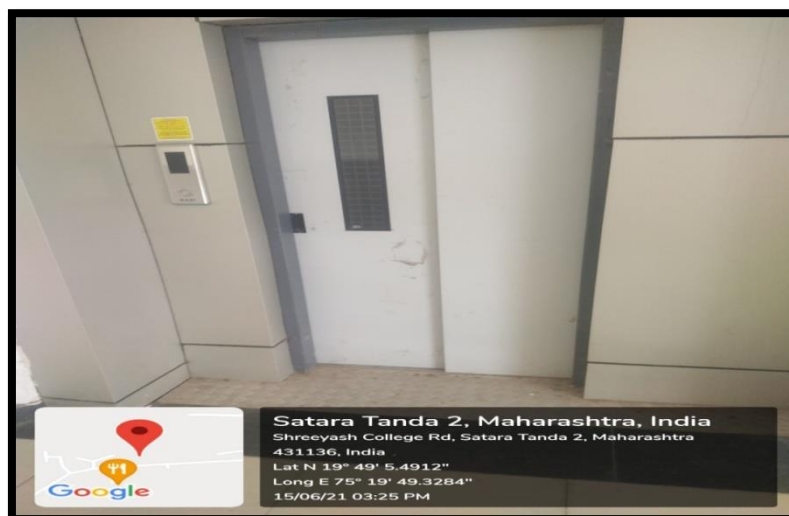


7.1.7 The Institution has disabled-friendly, barrier free environment

The lift facilities are available in the college where the disabled students can use it since it is designed to accommodate the students along with Wheel Chairs.



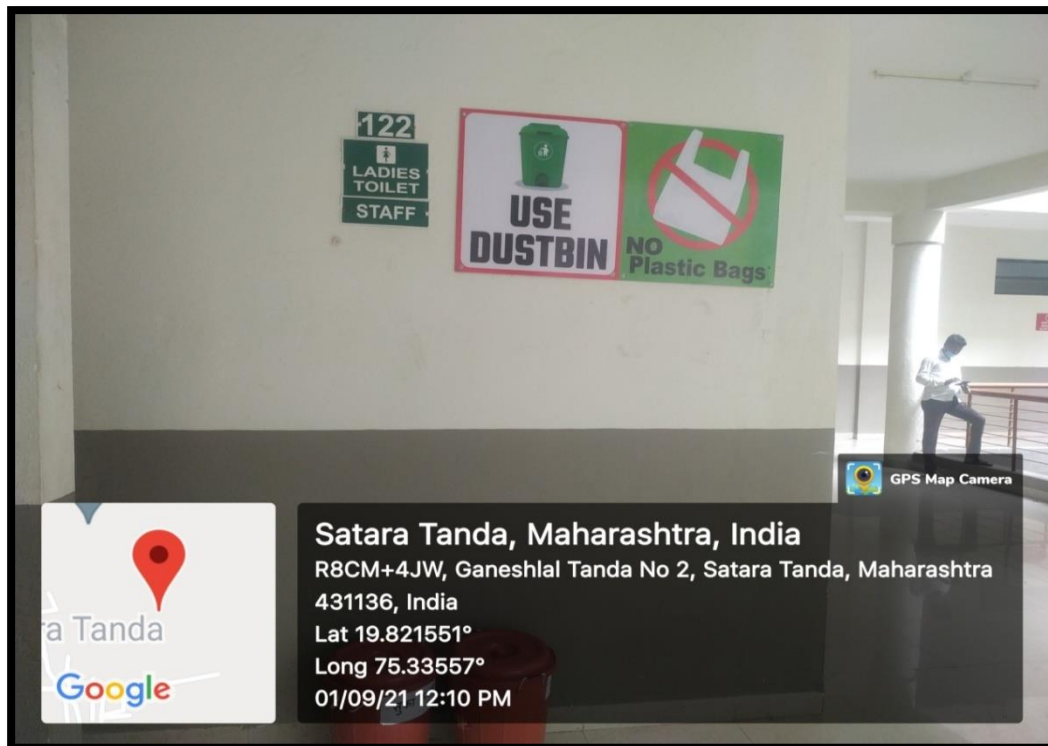
Wheel Chair as transportation aids for Physically Challenged Students for movement in Campus

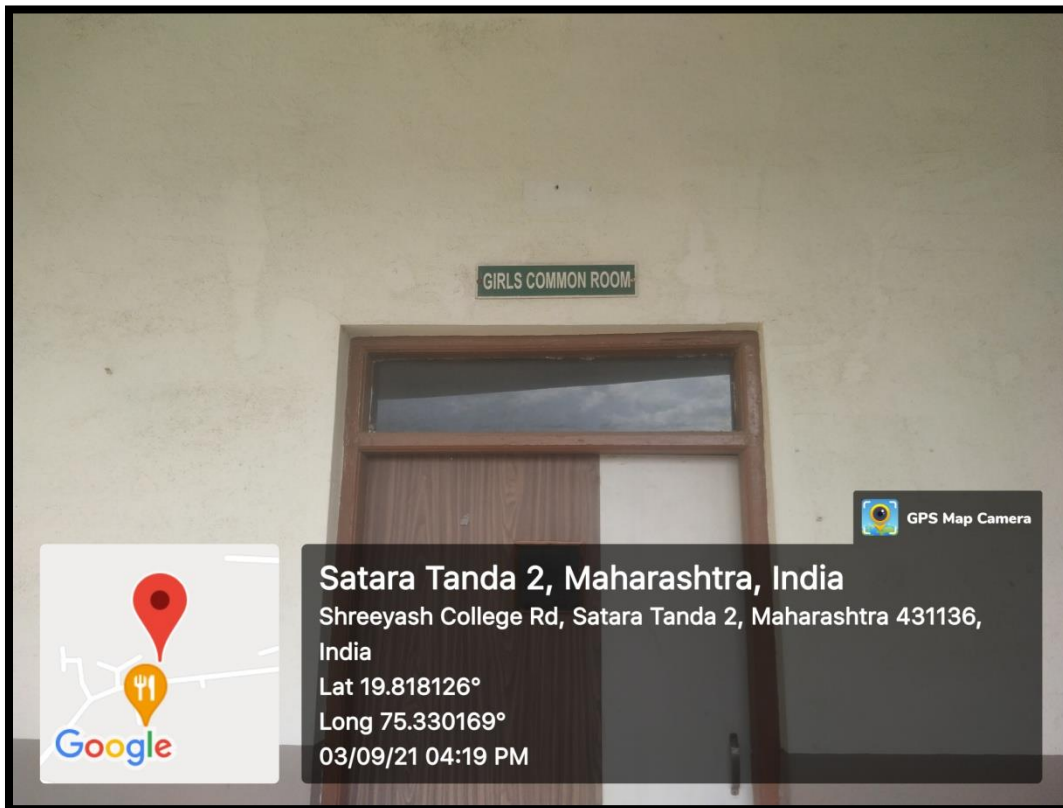


Toilet for Disabled Students
